## Master of Science in Applied Science

*The MSc in Applied Science Program is a research thesis-oriented, multidisciplinary degree program. The Program has a Cooperative Education Option which provides students practical work experience during 2 semesters of their Programs. Graduates from the Program have continued into PhD programs in the applied or basic sciences, and scientific and technical career positions in the government, private and educational sectors.*

### Admission Requirements

Normally an honours Bachelor's degree in Science from a recognized institution or the equivalent with a minimum cumulative quality point average of 3.0 (a 'B' standing) in the applicant's overall academic record.

Students whose first language is not English, and who have not attended an English language secondary school or have not completed a previous degree totally in English are required to take a standardized English Language Proficiency test.

### Funding

Financial support of up to \$15,000 per annum is available on a competitive basis.

\* Out-of-Province Canadian students will receive a tuition reduction bursary in the amount of \$261.
